


## Registration on CovidPass web site and its instructions for use

To register on the <https://covidpass.moh.gov.ge> web site, you must agree to the terms. After confirming the consent button, fill in the fields provided on the form and click the register button.

By clicking on the registration button, the personal data is checked in the following databases:

- Georgian Service Development Agency - for the purpose of identifying Georgian citizens / residents
- State Department of Border Crossing - for the purpose of identifying foreign nationals



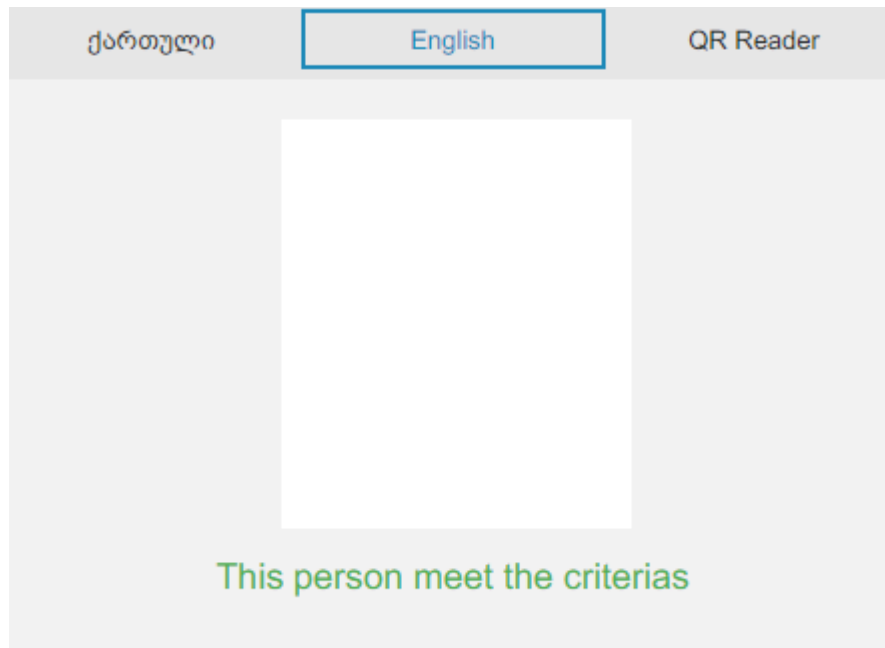

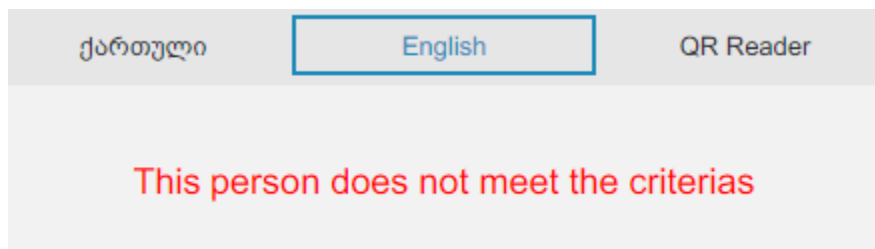
Upon successful registration, a QR code will be generated for you, which you can save on your phone, take a picture, print or save in another form.

In order to scan the QR code, you need to log in to <https://covidpass.moh.gov.ge> web site, in the menu using QR reader tool, scan the saved QR code. After scanning, a relevant message will appear on the phone screen:

- A) The mentioned person meets the criteria, a photograph of the person (in case of Georgian citizens) and initials (first initials of the name and surname (in green colour));



- B) The mentioned person does not meet the criteria (in red colour).



### **Covid pass use and validity period for both Georgian and foreign citizens:**

- **Full vaccination** (outside of Georgia) with Covid-19 vaccine (based on relevant documentation submitted at the border), valid for **9 months** after entering the border
- Covid-19 **negative** result (outside of Georgia) on PCR test (based on relevant documents submitted at the border), valid within **72 hours** of entering the border

- **Fully vaccination** on Covid-19 vaccine in Georgia (in case of Johnson I dose insufficient) (based on data from the National Center for Disease Control and Public Health (NCDC))
- 14 days after Covid-19 **confirmation** (based on NCDC data)
- Covid-19 **negative** PCR test result, valid within **72 hours** after conducting (based on NCDC data)
- Covid-19 **negative** antigen (rapid test) test result, valid within **24 hours** of conducting (based on NCDC data)
